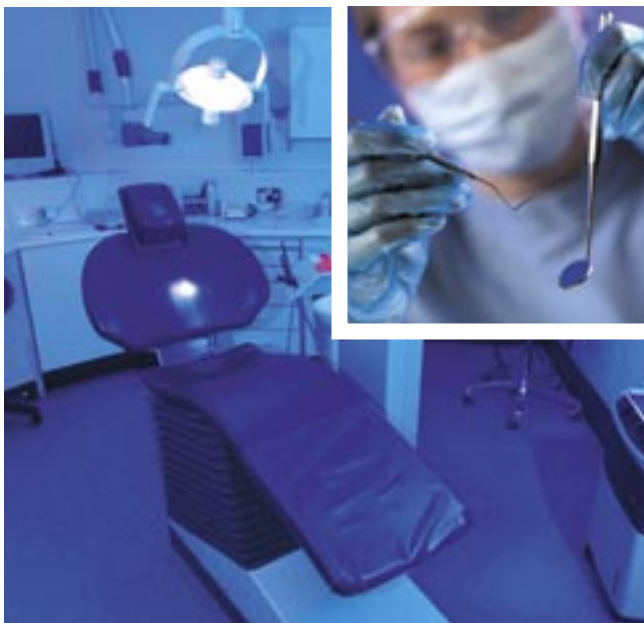

To ensure the complete safety of both your staff and patients, all of our amalgam storage units contain integral mercury suppressant foam to minimise the risk of mercury vapour poisoning.

- **Amalgam separator waste**

To ensure their efficiency and safety, amalgam separator systems need to be serviced and the waste emptied on a regular basis. PHS Wastemanagement provides a disposal service suitable for most brands of separator, including all Dürr systems.

- **X-ray waste**
